At its meeting held August 29, 2006, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Knabe made the following statement:

“A matter which presents a need to take immediate action has come to the County’s attention subsequent to the posting of the agenda for this meeting. The need for immediate action involves information received from the Sheriff’s Department this past weekend that all initial leads had been exhausted in the investigation of an incident of child molestation occurring on August 21, 2006, at Schabarum Park, and that new information, which may be prompted by the offer of a reward, was needed to pursue the investigation.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Knabe, seconded by Supervisor Antonovich, unanimously carried, the Board established a \$10,000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator responsible for the molestation of a child at Schabarum Park, in the Hacienda Heights area, on August 21, 2006.

**NOTICE OF \$10,000 REWARD
OFFERED BY THE
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is offering a \$10,000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator responsible for the molestation of a child at Schabarum Park, in the Hacienda Heights area, on August 21, 2006.

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Detective Novachek at the Los Angeles County Sheriff's City of Industry Station at (626) 934-3016 and refer to Report No. 006-14382-1479-120.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than November 27, 2006. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than January 26, 2007.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$10,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.

Any claims for the reward funds should be filed no later than January 26, 2007, with the Executive Officer of the Board of Supervisors, 500 West Temple Street, Room 383 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California 90012, Attention: Schabarum Park Child Molestation Reward Fund.
