At its meeting held September 19, 2006, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Yaroslavsky made the following statement:

“Members of the Pacific Jewish Center in Venice will be celebrating Rosh Hashanah (Jewish New Year) with its neighboring Congregation Mishkon Tephilo on Friday evening, September 22, 2006 at 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. Sunday evening, September 24, 2006. Yom Kippur (Day of Atonement) will also be celebrated on Sunday evening, October 1, 2006 from 6:00 p.m. until Monday, October 2, 2006 at 8:00 p.m.

“We have, in the past, waived parking fees at the Rose Avenue beach parking lot for congregants attending these High Holy Days services to allow for maximum participation at the Temple. Because the Pacific Jewish Center is an Orthodox Congregation, members cannot drive during the Holy Holidays and would require overnight parking until the Holiday is over.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Yaroslavsky, seconded by Supervisor Burke, unanimously carried (Supervisors Molina and Antonovich being absent), the Board waived the overnight parking fees for 30 vehicles totaling \$840.00, excluding the cost of liability insurance, at the Rose Avenue beach parking lot in Venice for the congregants attending the Pacific Jewish Center's High Holy Days services, to be held September 22, 23, and 24, 2006 and October 1 and 2, 2006.
