At its meeting held February 20, 2007, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Antonovich made the following statement:

“On Wednesday, February 14, 2007, between 9:00 and 9:30 p.m., 26-year-old Leon Huddleston was found severely beaten at “Young’s Tavern” in Lancaster. Mr. Huddleston suffered multiple skull fractures, a broken jaw and ribs and was bleeding from the head.

“The Sheriff’s Department is seeking assistance with information that may aid in their investigation of this heinous crime.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Knabe, unanimously carried (Supervisor Molina being absent), the Board approved the establishment of a \$10,000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the brutal beating of 26-year-old Leon Huddleston who suffered multiple injuries while at Young's Tavern in Lancaster, on February 14, 2007 between 9:00 and 9:30 p.m.

**NOTICE OF \$10,000 REWARD
OFFERED BY THE
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has established a \$10,000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the brutal beating of 26-year-old Leon Huddleston who suffered multiple injuries while at Young's Tavern in Lancaster, on February 14, 2007 between 9:00 and 9:30 p.m.

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Detective Brad Feehan at the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Lancaster Station at (661) 940-3845 and refer to Report No. 407-04026-1132-053.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than May 21, 2007. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than July 20, 2007.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$10,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.

Any claims for the reward funds should be filed no later than July 20, 2007 with the Executive Officer of the Board of Supervisors, 500 West Temple Street, Room 383 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California 90012, Attention: Leon Huddleston Reward Fund.
