The National Safety Council, California Chapter, is seeking support from the Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors in declaring June 2007 as National Safety Month.

This year's theme, "Celebrating Safe Communities," reflects the National Safety Council's mission to prevent accidental injury and death by educating and influencing people to adopt and maintain safe, healthy, and behavior practices in the workplace, roads and highways, homes, and our communities.
