At its meeting held June 12, 2007, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Burke made the following statement:

“On Saturday, June 9, 2007, a premier screening of the film, ‘Nancy Drew’ was held at the Grauman’s Chinese Theatre (6925 Hollywood Blvd., Hollywood, CA 90028) for 300 youth participating in Supervisor Burke’s 2007 Summer Reading Program from selected Second District schools and organizations.

“This screening of *Nancy Drew* is a public-private partnership with the Los Angeles County Second District to educate and empower youth through positive film imagery that promotes learning and problem-solving techniques.

“It has been 77 years since the creation of Nancy Drew. The first films were made in 1938-1939 by Warner Bros. called, ‘Nancy Drew-Detective.’ ‘Nancy Drew’ will be released June 15, 2007 worldwide by Warner Bros. Pictures.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Molina, seconded by Supervisor Knabe, unanimously carried (Supervisors Antonovich and Yaroslavsky being absent), the Board proclaimed June 15, 2007 as the official “Nancy Drew Day” throughout Los Angeles County in recognition of the premier screening presentation of the inspiring character of Nancy Drew.
