At its meeting held July 24, 2007, the Board took the following action:

At the time and place regularly set, notice having been duly given, the following item was called up:

Hearing on amendments to the County Code, Title 8 - Consumer Protection and Business Regulations and Title 20 - Utilities, to increase public health license, permit and service fees by approximately five percent effective Fiscal Year 2007-08, to allow the Department of Public Health's Environmental Health Division to recover revenue due to increased service costs, as further described in the attached letter dated July 24, 2007 from the Director of Public Health.

Opportunity was given for interested persons to address the Board. No interested persons addressed the Board. No correspondence was presented.

Supervisor Knabe requested the Chief Executive Officer to report back to the Board prior to next year's fee increases, on whether the Department of Public Health's Environmental Health Division is operating in the most cost effective way possible and whether yearly increases of this nature are disproportionately harmful to small locally owned restaurants.

On motion of Supervisor Burke, seconded by Supervisor Molina, unanimously carried (Supervisor Antonovich being absent), the Board closed the hearing and approved Supervisor Knabe's aforementioned recommendation and introduced, waived reading and adopted the attached Ordinance No. 2007-0088 entitled, "An ordinance amending Title 8 - Consumer Protection and Business Regulations and Title 20 - Utilities of the Los Angeles County Code by increasing the public health inspection fees found in Title 8 and increasing the fees found in Section 20.64.110, Permit and Regulatory Fees." This ordinance shall take effect August 23, 2007.
