

MOTION BY SUPERVISOR MICHAEL D. ANTONOVICH

Fighting gang violence and protecting our communities from violent gang members is a high priority in our County. To enhance our efforts in that regard, the Sheriff's personnel who conduct the immigration interviews should give priority to those inmates on their interview list who are known gang members. Every known gang member who is on the list for an interview should be interviewed prior to release back into our communities.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors request the Sheriff to modify its 287(g) program such that inmates who are on their interview lists and are also known gang members are given priority for interviews.

I, FURTHER, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors direct the Chief Executive Officer to work with the Sheriff to determine if the Sheriff's existing resources are adequate to ensure that all known gang members on the interview list are interviewed prior to release from jail and report back in 30 days.
