At its meeting held September 23, 2008, the Board took the following action:

At the time and place regularly set, notice having been duly given, the following item was called up:

Hearing on amendments to the County Code, Title 15 - Vehicles and Traffic, to establish the Fir Avenue Preferential Parking District in the unincorporated community of Florence-Firestone (2), and imposition of a permit fee of \$120 per household within the District, renewable every three years to cover all County costs of issuance of parking permits, fabrication and installation of permit parking signs and administration of the Parking District; also find that the proposed ordinance is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act; as further described in the attached letter dated September 23, 2008 from the Acting Director of Public Works.

Opportunity was given for interested persons to address the Board. No interested persons addressed the Board. No correspondence was presented.

On motion of Supervisor Burke, seconded by Supervisor Yaroslavsky, duly carried by the following vote: Ayes: Supervisors Molina, Yaroslavsky and Burke; Noes: None, (Supervisors Knabe and Antonovich being absent) the Board closed the hearing and took the following actions:

1. Made a finding that the proposed ordinance is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act;
2. Approved establishment of the Fir Avenue Preferential Parking District in the unincorporated community of Florence-Firestone and imposed a preferential permit fee in the amount of \$120 per household renewable every three years;

3. Introduced, waived reading and ordered placed on the agenda of October 7, 2008 for adoption the attached ordinance entitled, "An ordinance amending Title 15 - Vehicles and Traffic of the Los Angeles County Code to establish the Fir Avenue Preferential Parking District.";
4. Authorized the Acting Director of Public Works to issue parking permits, post, and maintain permit parking signs for the Fir Avenue Preferential Parking District at the time the recommended ordinance becomes effective; and
5. Requested the Sheriff's Department to enforce the Preferential Parking District restrictions when effective.
