At its meeting held October 7, 2008, the Board took the following action:

The following statement was entered into the record for Supervisor Burke:

“On July 15, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved a reward offer of \$10,000 for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of 60-year old James Hurst. The reward will expire on October 13, 2008.

“On Saturday, July 5, 2008 at approximately 7:00 p.m., 60-year old James Hurst was fatally assaulted by three black male suspects in Ted Watkins Park located near Century Boulevard and Success Avenue in an unincorporated area bordering Watts.

“Mr. Hurst was sleeping on the ground when one juvenile, and two adult, black male suspects attempted to rob him. He was hit with a blunt object to the head 2-3 times and lost consciousness. Mr. Hurst was taken to St. Francis Medical Center in Lynwood where he died the following day”.

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Burke, seconded by Supervisor Antonovich, unanimously carried (Supervisor Knabe being absent), the Board extended the \$10,000 reward offered for any information leading to the arrest and/or conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of 60-year old James Hurst who was assaulted by three black male suspects in Ted Watkins Park located near Century Blvd. and Success Ave., in an unincorporated area bordering Watts on Saturday, July 5, 2008 at approximately 7:00 p.m.

**NOTICE OF \$10,000 REWARD
OFFERED BY THE
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has extended the \$10,000 reward offered for any information leading to the arrest and/or conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of 60-year old James Hurst who was assaulted by three black male suspects in Ted Watkins Park located near Century Blvd. and Success Ave., in an unincorporated area bordering Watts on Saturday, July 5, 2008 at approximately 7:00 p.m.

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Detectives Barron or Peyton at the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Homicide Bureau at (323) 890-5500 and refer to Report No. 008-14711-2176-011.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than April 11, 2009. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than June 10, 2009.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$10,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.

Any claims for the reward funds should be filed no later than June 10, 2009, with the Executive Office of the Board of Supervisors, 500 West Temple Street, Room 383 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California 90012, Attention: James Hurst Reward Fund.
