The following item was called up for consideration:

Report by the Chief Executive Officer and Interim Director of Health Services on the possibility that the \$33 million in efficiency savings taken from the Martin Luther King Multi-Service Ambulatory Care Center (MLK MACC) Fiscal Year 2008-09 Final Budget, and placed in a designated Provisional Financing Uses budget, can be used for the following, as requested by Supervisor Molina at the meeting of June 17, 2008:

Support infrastructure development, primary and specialty care expansion of the Public Private Partnership program throughout the County to address the under-equity in services; or

If the visits to MLK MACC exceed 150,000 per year, use the funds to expand care at MLK MACC.

Genevieve Clavreul and Arnold Sachs addressed the Board.

After discussion, on motion of Supervisor Knabe, seconded by Supervisor Antonovich, unanimously carried, the Board received and filed the attached report by the Interim Director of Health Services regarding patient visits projections for the MLK MACC.
