At its meeting held October 21, 2008, the Board took the following action:

The following statement was entered into the record for Supervisor Knabe:

“The Los Angeles County Arts Commission will host the Americans for the Arts Knowledge Exchange on the work of Arts for All on Monday, October 27 and Tuesday, October 28, 2008. Over the two-days convening, 100 arts, business, education, and government leaders from across the nation will explore Los Angeles County’s Arts for All initiative through interactive workshops and dialogues with partners from participating school districts, district arts coaches, the Arts for All Pooled Fund and the Arts for All Executive Committee.”

Therefore, at the suggestion of Supervisor Knabe, and on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Molina, unanimously carried (Supervisor Knabe being absent), the Board took the following actions:

1. Requested the Music Center to:
 - Waive the \$62.50 fee for the use of the Rigler-Deutsch Board Room on October 27 and 28, 2008, for the Americans for the Arts Knowledge Exchange;
 - Waive the \$250 Founders Room rental fee for a reception for the local and national founders on October 28, 2008 from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.; and
 - Waive the \$275 room rental fee for the Grand Hall of the Dorothy Chandler Pavilion for the Arts for All Progress Report Dinner to be held October 28, 2008, from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m., excluding the cost of liability insurance; and
2. Waived the parking fees for up to 300 vehicles totaling \$2,400 at the Music Center Garage for attendees of the Arts for All Progress Report Dinner, hosted by the Los Angeles County Arts Commission.
