The following statement was entered into the record for Supervisor Antonovich:

“On January 13, 2004, 24-year-old Anthony Lofton was shot and killed while at Jim’s Burgers located on Lincoln Avenue near Woodbury Drive in Altadena. Two witnesses reported seeing a male black in a hooded sweatshirt running from the burger stand immediately after the gunshot was heard but no suspects are in custody to date.

“The Sheriff’s Homicide Bureau is seeking assistance from the public to aid in their investigation.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Knabe, unanimously carried (Supervisor Molina being absent), the Board established a \$10,000 reward for any information leading to the apprehension and/or conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of 24-year-old Anthony Lofton, who was shot and killed at Jim’s Burgers located on Lincoln Avenue near Woodbury Drive, in Altadena on January 13, 2004.

**NOTICE OF \$10,000 REWARD  
OFFERED BY THE  
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has established a \$10,000 reward for any information leading to the apprehension and/or conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of 24-year-old Anthony Lofton, who was shot and killed at Jim's Burgers located on Lincoln Ave. near Woodbury Dr., in Altadena on January 13, 2004.

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Detective Barron of the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Homicide Bureau at (323) 890-5500 and refer to Report No. 004-00185-0772.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than March 2, 2009. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than May 1, 2009.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$10,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.

Any claims for the reward funds should be filed no later than May 1, 2009, with the Executive Office of the Board of Supervisors, 500 West Temple Street, Room 383 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California 90012, Attention: Anthony Lofton Reward Fund.
