**DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION:  
APPROVAL OF SUPPLEMENTAL SALARY REQUEST  
(SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICT 5) (3 VOTES)**

**SUBJECT**

The Department of Parks and Recreation is requesting the authorization of a payment of \$12,000 annually to Mr. Tim Phillips, Superintendent, Arboretum, to supplement his salary for his acting appointment as Executive Officer, Arboretum. The payment will be made by the California Arboretum Foundation.

**IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:**

Authorize a monthly payment of \$1,000 to Tim Phillips, Superintendent, Arboretum by the California Arboretum Foundation, as supplement to his County salary, effective upon approval by your Board.

**PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION**

The California Arboretum Foundation (Foundation) has requested that the Board of Supervisors approve payment of \$1,000 per month by the Foundation to supplement Mr. Phillips' County salary as compensation for his acting appointment as Executive Officer, Arboretum, of the Los Angeles County Arboretum & Botanic Garden (Arboretum). Mr. Phillips has been in the acting capacity since June 27, 2008, when the incumbent vacated the position. The supplemental salary shall not be paid longer than 12 months or shall cease should Mr. Phillips have a change in assignment or status, whichever occurs first.

Mr. Phillips' responsibilities include managing the overall operations of the Arboretum, with a budget of \$3.5 million, and a staff of more than 53 personnel, as well as representing the County as the liaison to the Foundation. Additionally, Mr. Phillips is responsible for providing oversight and direction in developing programs and fundraising activities benefiting the Arboretum, in collaboration with the Foundation and other organizations. Mr. Phillips also represents the Arboretum before community groups, institutional and professional organizations, and individuals to discuss matters related to the mission and operation of the Arboretum.

### **Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals**

The implementation of the action is consistent with the County Strategic Plan Goals of Service Excellence (Goal 1) and Plan Workforce Excellence (Goal 2), by investing in management personnel at the qualified level and offering a wide range of services to the public that are both beneficial and responsive.

### **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING**

This action has no impact on the County General Fund.

California Arboretum Foundation will supplement Mr. Phillips' regular County salary in the amount of \$1,000 per month, as long as Mr. Phillips continues in his current assignment as Acting Executive Officer, Arboretum.

### **Operating Budget Impact**

There is no impact to the Department's Operating Budget as the recommended actions will result in no net County Cost.

### **FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS**

Section 5.44.030 of the Los Angeles County Code (County Code) allows, upon approval from your Board, employees of the County to receive supplementary salary compensation from any association, nonprofit corporation, or organization for services rendered to the County or to said association. Consistent with County Code, a statement will be filed with the Auditor-Controller by the 30<sup>th</sup> of September of each year disclosing the names of all employees receiving supplementary salaries and their respective amount of compensation.
