At its meeting held February 24, 2009 the Board took the following action:

The following statement was entered into the record for Supervisor Molina:

“On March 27, 2004, at approximately 11:00 p.m., Pauline Squires was tragically killed; her friend, Michael Braier, was seriously injured in a vehicle-pedestrian collision at the intersection of Azusa Avenue and Fourth Street in the City of Azusa. The vehicle that struck Pauline and Michael was driven by an unidentified person who fled the scene. To date, the identity of the driver remains unknown. Pauline Squires was a 23-year-old who left behind two loving parents and a sister. Investigators strongly believe that someone has information about this case, and they are seeking the public’s assistance in bringing the perpetrators of this heinous crime to justice. Anyone with information about this case is urged to contact Corporal Dean Brewer with the Azusa Police Department at (626) 812-3200 as soon as possible.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Molina, seconded by Supervisor Knabe, unanimously carried, the Board extended the \$10,000 reward offered for any information leading to the apprehension and/or conviction of the person or persons responsible for the vehicle-pedestrian collision that resulted in the death of 23-year-old Pauline Squires at the intersection of Azusa Avenue and Fourth Street, in the City of Azusa, on March 27, 2004, at approximately 11:00 p.m.

**NOTICE OF \$10,000 REWARD  
OFFERED BY THE  
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has extended the \$10,000 reward offered for any information leading to the apprehension and/or conviction of the person responsible for the vehicle-pedestrian collision that resulted in the death of 23-year-old Pauline Squires at the intersection of Azusa Avenue and Fourth Street, in the City of Azusa, on March 27, 2004, at approximately 11:00 p.m.

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Corporal Dean Brewer of the Azusa Police Department at (626) 812-3200 and refer to Report No. 2004-1933.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than August 29, 2009. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than October 28, 2009.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$10,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.

Any claims for the reward funds should be filed no later than October 28, 2009, with the Executive Office of the Board of Supervisors, 500 West Temple Street, Room 383 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California 90012, Attention: Pauline Squires Reward Fund.
