

**NOTICE OF \$10,000 REWARD  
OFFERED BY THE  
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has established a reward in amount of \$10,000 for any information leading to the apprehension and/or conviction of the person or persons responsible for the hit-and-run murder of Adrianna Bachan and attempted murder of Marcus Garfinkle, two University of Southern California students, which occurred in a crosswalk at the corner of Jefferson Street at Hoover Street in the City of Los Angeles, at approximately 3:00 a.m. on Sunday, March 29, 2009.

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Detective Jimmy Render at the Los Angeles Police Department South Traffic Division at (323) 290-6063 and refer to Report No. 09-0310750.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than June 29, 2009. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than August 28, 2009.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$10,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.
