
Dear Ms. Hamai:

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RESOLUTION NO. 09-27

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD CALIFORNIA, REQUESTING THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF LOS ANGELES TO RENDER SPECIFIED SERVICES TO THE CITY RELATING TO THE CONDUCT OF THE MUNICIPAL RUNOFF ELECTION TO BE HELD ON TUESDAY, JUNE 16, 2009

WHEREAS, a Municipal Runoff Election is to be held in the City of Inglewood, California, on Tuesday, June 16, 2009; and

WHEREAS, in the course of conduct of the election it is necessary for the City of Inglewood ("City") to request services from the County of Los Angeles ("County"); and

WHEREAS, all necessary expenses in performing these services shall be paid by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF INGLEWOOD, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That pursuant to the provisions of §10002 of the Elections Code of the State of California, the City of Inglewood requests the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles to permit the County Registrar Recorder to prepare and furnish the following for use in conducting the election:

1. A listing of county precincts with the number of registered voters in each, so the City may consolidate election precincts into city voting precincts and maps of the voting precincts;
2. A list of polling places and poll workers the County uses for its elections;
3. The computer records of the names and address of all eligible registered voters in the City in order that the City's consultant may:
 - a. Produce labels for vote-by-mail voters;
 - b. Produce labels for sample ballot pamphlets;
 - c. Print rosters of voters and street indexes;
4. Voter signature verification services as needed;
5. Make available to the City election equipment and assistance as needed according to state law.

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SECTION 2. That the City shall reimburse the County for services performed when the work is completed and upon presentation to the City of a properly approved bill.

SECTION 3. That the City Clerk is directed to forward without delay to the Board of Supervisors and to the County Registrar Recorder, each a certified copy of this resolution.

SECTION 4. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the Book of Original Resolutions.
