**Reward Offer**

On May 8, 2009, at about 7:58 p.m., the residence located at 2058 Broach Avenue in Duarte was discovered burglarized, ransacked, and numerous racial epithets had been spray painted throughout the interior of the house. One of the epithets spray painted inside the house was associated with the gang Duarte Eastside.

The Hate Crimes Task Force is investigating this crime and the Sheriff's Department is seeking assistance from the public to aid in their investigation. In the meantime, the victims have been displaced and require public assistance with temporary housing.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE THAT the Board of Supervisors:

1. Offer a reward in the amount of \$10,000 in exchange for any information that will lead to the arrest and/or conviction of the suspect(s) who burglarized, ransacked, and spray painted numerous racial epithets throughout the interior of the house located at 2058 Broach Avenue in Duarte on May 8;
2. Direct the Department of Public Social Services to provide homelessness prevention assistance and all available public assistance resources to the victims; and,
3. Direct the Human Relation Commission to provide appropriate support and assistance to the victims as well as to the surrounding community and the Hate Crimes Task Force.
