APPROVE THE KENNETH HAHN HALL OF ADMINISTRATION ROOM 866 REFURBISHMENT PROJECT (C.P. NO. 87080) AND APPROVE PROJECT BUDGET (SECOND DISTRICT) (3 VOTES)

SUBJECT

Approve the refurbishment and reconfiguration of existing space within Room 866 of the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

- 1. Find that the proposed project is categorically exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act Sections 15301 (a), and (d) of the State CEQA Guideline; and the revised County of Los Angeles Environmental Document Reporting Procedures and Guidelines Class 1 (d) adopted by your Board on November 17, 1987, because the project involves minor interior alterations of the building involving no or negligible expansion of an existing use.
- Establish and approve Capital Project Number 87080 for Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration Room 866 Refurbishment Project to refurbish and reconfigure existing offices, with a total budget of \$707,000.
- 3. Authorize Internal Services Department to deliver the project.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

Approval of the recommended actions will allow Internal Services Department (ISD) to implement the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration (KHHOA) Room 866 Refurbishment project.

The proposed project consists of replacing carpet/floor tiles, ceilings, lighting, interior wood work, air conditioning retrofit, electrical and plumbing. The proposed project will be implemented through ISD in-house crafts and the Board-approved Job Order Contract (JOC) program. ISD in-house crafts will be replacing ceiling and lighting, painting, replacing carpet and tile, disconnecting and reconnecting power/voice/data line, replacing thermostats, ductwork/grills, demolition work and clean up. Job Order Contracting will refurbish interior wood work, window and wall treatments by replacing blind, curtain, and acoustic fabric panels; and will remove the existing kitchenette, and relocate plumbing and electrical lines for the kitchenette. The acquisition and installation of the modular and related office furniture will be purchased through ISD from an approved County agreement vendor separately, as it does not constitute a capital project. The proposed furniture will be funded from the Second District Discretionary Fund and is not part of the proposed project budget. The refurbishment project is anticipated to be completed in six months.

Sustainable Design Program

The proposed project will support your Board's Policy for Green Building/Sustainable Design Program (GB/SD) to the extent feasible by using building materials that are composed of recycled materials. The recycled demolition materials will include natural fibers from old carpet. The use of recycled building materials and modular furniture supports the GB/SD Policy by reducing the amount of demolition materials that would be disposed in landfills; reducing the production of synthetic materials that contribute to carbon emissions; and reducing the consumption of natural resources.

Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals

Approval of the recommended actions is consistent with the County's Strategic Plan Goals of Operational Effectiveness (Goal 1) by investing in public infrastructure.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

The estimated project cost is \$707,000, including base refurbishment/construction, contingency fund, County services, Civic Art fee and other related project costs. Sufficient appropriation is available for the proposed project in the Fiscal Year 2009-10

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Capital Projects/Refurbishments Budget under C.P. No. 87080, KHHOA Room 866 Refurbishment project. The Project Schedule and Budget Summary are included in Attachment A.

The proposed project is funded with the Second District's Discretionary Fund net County cost.

FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

As required by your Board, the project cost includes one percent of design and refurbishment/construction costs to be allocated to the Civic Art Fund per your Board's Civic Art Policy adopted on December 7, 2004.

ENVIRONMENTAL DOCUMENTATION

The proposed project is categorically exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301(a),(d) and Class 1, Subsection (d) of the County of Los Angeles Environmental Document Reporting Procedures and Guidelines adopted by your Board on November 17, 1987, because the project involves minor interior alterations of the building involving no or negligible expansion of an existing use, including the addition of safety devices in conjunction with existing structures.

CONTRACTING PROCESS

The proposed renovation project will be delivered utilizing a combination of the ISD inhouse crafts personnel and the Board-approved JOC program under the management of ISD.

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES

The recommended actions will not impact County services or current projects at this location.
