Intent of Senate Bill 18 (3X), Provisions in the Budget Act, & Administrative Reforms

To enhance public safety by:

- Enabling parole agents to concentrate their limited resources on the most serious offenders.**
- Increased resources, in the form of GPS and electronic monitoring, to enhance supervision and compliance with conditions of parole.**

Intent of Senate Bill 18 (3X), Provisions in the Budget Act, & Administrative Reforms

- **Enhanced credit earning for inmates that complete programs proven to ease their transition into society;**
- **Expansion of drug and mental health reentry courts to enable parolees to receive highly-structured treatment.**

- **Implementation of a new outcome-based case parole supervision model intended to enhance parolee success.**
- **Creation of a Field Training Officer Program as a means by which to enhance the proficiency of parole agents;**
- **Creation of expanded Parolee At Large apprehension teams**
