Supervisor Knabe made the following statement:

“Each year, ‘National Public Works Week’ serves as a reminder of the value public works professionals contribute to our lives. As part of this celebration, public works officials strive to increase public awareness and appreciation of their profession.

“Public works, such as roads, bridges, airports, sewers, and water and flood control facilities, are a vital and integral part of our daily lives. The health, safety, comfort, and quality of life of Los Angeles County residents depend on these facilities and services.

“The quality and effectiveness of our public works depend on the efforts and skill of public works officials. We all owe a debt of gratitude to the dedicated personnel who staff our public works departments.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Knabe, seconded by Supervisor Molina, unanimously carried, the Board designated May 18 through 24, 2003 as "National Public Works Week" throughout Los Angeles County. In addition, the Board urged all citizens and civic organizations to acquaint themselves with the challenges involved in providing public works services, and to recognize the contributions that public works officials make every day to our health, safety, comfort and quality of life.
