

MOTION BY SUPERVISOR DON KNABE

On Friday, September 10, 2010, shortly before 10:30 p.m., Long Beach police officers responded to a shooting that had just occurred in the 1000-block of Lewis Avenue. When officers arrived, they discovered the victim 23 year-old Brian Humphries, a well known and liked resident from the neighborhood lying in the parkway on the street. Humphries had sustained a gunshot wounds to his upper torso and was taken to a local hospital where he later died.

Detectives have learned there were numerous witnesses standing in front of their residences on the night of the murder, yet few witnesses have come forward so far. Detectives feel it would be beneficial to offer a reward, which may prompt reluctant witnesses to come forward and provide information to identify the individuals responsible for this crime. They can remain anonymous.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors offer a \$10,000 dollar reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s) of this heinous crime.
