**APPROVAL TO EXECUTE 137 ALCOHOL AND DRUG SERVICE AGREEMENTS FOR DRUG  
MEDI-CAL SERVICES WITH VARIOUS AGENCIES EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2011 THROUGH JUNE  
30, 2014  
(ALL SUPERVISORIAL DISTRICTS) (3 VOTES)**

**SUBJECT**

Approval to: 1) execute Drug Medi-Cal program services agreements with 41 agencies referred by the State Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs; 2) execute 96 renewal Drug Medi-Cal program services agreements; and 3) terminate Drug Medi-Cal agreements that are non-compliant with California Code of Regulation, Title 22, and Drug/Medi-Cal requirements.

**IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:**

1. Approve and instruct the Director of the Department of Public Health (DPH), or his designee, to execute 41 new alcohol and drug service agreements with the agencies referred to the County of Los Angeles (County) by the State Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (State) as listed in Attachment A, for the provision of Drug Medi-Cal (DMC) program services effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2014, contingent upon the agency's submission and approval by DPH of all required documents, including a performance security bond in the form of either a Certification of Deposit (COD) or a Letter of Credit (LOC), as required by DPH, at a total County maximum obligation of \$36,971,019, 100 percent offset by federal and State funds.
2. Approve and instruct the Director of DPH, or his designee, to execute 96 renewal alcohol and drug services DMC agreements with the agencies listed in Attachment B, effective July 1, 2011 through June 30, 2014, at a total maximum County obligation of \$200,105,421; 100 percent offset by federal and State funds.

3. Delegate authority to the Director of DPH, or his designee, to offer and execute future alcohol and drug services agreements for the provision of DMC program services to all eligible State-certified DMC agencies, either effective upon agency DMC certification date or July 1 of the current fiscal year (FY) or upon the start date requested by the agency between these two time periods, upon the agency's submission and approval by DPH of all required documents, including a performance security bond in the form of either COD or LOC, as required by DPH, subject to review and approval by County Counsel, and notification to your Board and the Chief Executive Office (CEO), allowing for State approved retroactive payments through June 30, 2014; 100 percent offset by federal and State funds.
4. Delegate authority to the Director of DPH, or his designee, to execute amendments to DMC agreements that increase or decrease the contractual maximum obligations, and/or provide an internal reallocation of funds between budgets pursuant to the federal ruling of Sobky v. Smoley, subject to review and approval by County Counsel, and notification to your Board and the CEO.
5. Delegate authority to the Director of DPH, or his designee, to terminate agreements with State-certified DMC agencies contracted with DPH through June 30, 2014, that establish a repeated inability to correct deficiencies and/or failure to fully comply with California Code of Regulation, Title 22, and Drug/Medi-Cal requirements, following County Counsel review and approval, and notification to your Board and the CEO.

#### **PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION**

Approval of the recommended actions will allow DPH to: 1) contract with DMC agencies that currently contract with the State, contingent upon approval by DPH of all documents required to meet the qualification criteria; 2) renew existing DMC agreements for a period of three-years; 3) execute future DMC agreements with eligible providers; 4) make funding adjustments to all DMC agreements, pursuant to the federal ruling of Sobky v. Smoley; and 4) terminate DMC agreements.

The State administers and provides State and federal funds to the County to provide DMC contract services through State-certified agencies. In the past, the State will contract directly with an agency with whom the County had declined to contract. This practice has resulted in two systems of contracting for DMC services: 1) a group of agencies that currently contract with the County and 2) another group that has direct contracts with the State.

Effective July 2011, to eliminate this dual contracting system, the State is requiring counties to execute contracts with those agencies currently contracted with the State for DMC services. Funds will continue to be provided through the State, however, the DMC contracts will be entirely the responsibility of counties. In taking over this responsibility DPH, in consultation with County Counsel, has developed qualifying criteria to document an agency's eligibility, including the requirement that agencies with less than four years experience providing alcohol and drug services present a performance security bond.

#### **Implementation of Strategic Plan Goals**

The recommended actions support Goal 2, Children, Family and Adult Well-Being; and Goal 4, Health and Mental Health, of the County's Strategic Plan.

## **FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING**

The County, through DPH's Substance Abuse Prevention and Control (SAPC), has a Combined Negotiated Net Amount (NNA) and DMC Agreement with the State which provides funding support for the provision of alcohol and drug services in Los Angeles County. Under the Combined NNA/DMC Agreement, the State agrees to cover the cost of all DMC services provided to Medi-Cal beneficiaries.

The Combined NNA/DMC Agreement provides federal block grant and State General Funds to support alcohol and drug program services including DMC services for the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013. DPH anticipates a new Combined NNA/DMC agreement with the State to be issued effective July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2016 for continued funding.

SAPC receives administrative revenue for overseeing and monitoring DMC programs. This revenue represents ten percent of SAPC's total DMC budget.

## **FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS**

As a result of the Sobky v. Smoley federal ruling, the federal court ordered the State to: 1) ensure availability of Medi-Cal methadone maintenance treatment services throughout the State, either through direct contracts or through subcontracts with various counties, where licensed methadone maintenance treatment programs are available to non-Medi-Cal patients; 2) expedite requests by licensed methadone maintenance treatment agencies for DMC provider certification; 3) ensure that all DMC eligible persons receive methadone maintenance treatment services with reasonable promptness; and 4) ensure that no DMC eligible person is put on a waiting list to receive services due to budgetary constraints. While the court's judgment specifically focused on methadone maintenance treatment services, the State applied the judgment to all drug abuse treatment programs supported by DMC funding. The court's ruling includes County DMC contracts supported by State DMC funds.

On June 15, 2010, your Board approved acceptance of the Combined NNA/DMC Agreement, effective July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013, for funding in the amount of \$418,054,209 for the provision of alcohol and drug services. This Combined NNA/DMC Agreement includes funding of \$36,843,792 for FY 2010-11; \$31,383,127 for FY 2011-12, and \$31,382,127 for FY 2012-13 for DMC services. The DMC portion of the Combined NNA/DMC Agreement is used to fund agreements with all State-certified DMC service agencies approved to have contracts with the County, effective upon certification date. The State agreed to fund the agreements, effective the date of certification, or July 1 of the current fiscal year, whichever start date is requested by the agency, allowing for State-approved retroactive payments to the agency.

The agencies listed in Attachment A are currently not contracted with DPH. Qualifying documentation required from these agencies include: DMC and Alcohol and/or Other Drug certifications, Articles of Incorporation, Evidence of Insurance, and Bylaws. Further, DPH is utilizing the County's Insurance Manual, specifically Performance Security, to minimize any financial risks to the County.

The recommended agreements will be reviewed and approved by County Counsel prior to execution.

Attachment C is a listing of the Executive Directors of the recommended agencies.


**CONTRACTING PROCESS**

New agreements will only be executed with those agencies that are State-certified to provide DMC services and that meet DPH's qualifying criteria which include submission of all required documentation and a performance security bond in the form of either a COD or LOC.

**IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)**

Approval of the recommended actions will allow DPH to be in compliance with State requirements and contract with State-certified DMC agencies to ensure that DMC services continue without interruption throughout Los Angeles County.
