Protecting the County's Safety Net System of Clinics

On April 22, 2008, the Board of Supervisors (Board) adopted an equitable countywide funding allocation methodology for the Public Private Partnership (PPP) clinic program which shows certain geographic areas of the County are more underserved than others.

While the Board approved \$44.8 Million for one-time Community Clinic Expansion Program (CCEP) funds to partially address geographic density of unmet needs, those funds are set to expire at the end of next year.

The County needs to ensure its entire safety net system is protected as it prepares to implement the Section 1115 waiver and Affordable Care Act.

THEREFORE, I MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

Direct the Chief Executive Officer and the Director of the Department of Health Services to report back in 90 days, and monthly thereafter, with data regarding enrollment trends in the Healthy Way LA Matched and Unmatched programs.
