The Special Olympics Southern California is a non-profit organization that empowers individuals with intellectual disabilities to become physically fit, productive and respected members of society through sports training and competition. It is one of 52 Chapters within the United States and part of Special Olympics, Inc., which serves 2.5 million athletes worldwide, including Southern California.

The Special Olympics Southern California will be hosting a Polar Plunge fundraiser event at Zuma Beach, on February 18, 2012 in partnership with the Los County Angeles Sheriff's and Police Departments.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE, that the Board of Supervisors instruct the Director of the Department of Beach and Harbors to (1) reduce the permit fee to \$100.00, (2) reduce parking to \$5.00 per vehicle and (3) waive the estimated gross receipts in the amount of \$1,250.00, excluding the cost of liability insurance for the Polar Plunge Fundraiser event at Zuma Beach on February 18, 2012.
