The City of Los Angeles currently has an agreement with the Emergency Management Air Support Wing comprised of trained volunteer pilots drawn from the National organization known as Angel Flight for emergency air response. These volunteers own and operate their personal aircraft and assist the City by bringing outside responders into the City as well as delivering food or medical supplies to designated locations. All volunteer pilots have gone through background checks and met the City's requirement of 1,000 hours of flying time.

The Emergency Management Air Support Wing is interested in establishing a similar agreement with the County of Los Angeles for emergency air services to the Sheriff's Aero Bureau.
