At its meeting held July 29, 2003, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Antonovich made the following statement:

“The City of Los Angeles currently has an agreement with the Emergency Management Air Support Wing comprised of trained volunteer pilots drawn from the National organization known as Angel Flight for emergency air response. These volunteers own and operate their personal aircraft and assist the City by bringing outside responders into the City as well as delivering food or medical supplies to designated locations.

“All volunteer pilots have gone through background checks and met the City’s requirement of 1,000 hours of flying time. The Emergency Management Air Support Wing is interested in establishing a similar agreement with the County of Los Angeles for emergency air services to the Sheriff’s Aero Bureau.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Antonovich, seconded by Supervisor Yaroslavsky, unanimously carried (Supervisor Molina being absent), the Sheriff, Chief Administrative Officer and County Counsel were requested to:

1. Review the Emergency Management Air Support Wing's request to establish an agreement similar to that of the City of Los Angeles' for emergency air services to the Sheriff's Aero Bureau;
2. Review the City of Los Angeles' agreement with the Emergency Management Air Support Wing; and
