At its meeting held July 29, 2003, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Yaroslavsky made the following statement:

“In response to my motion of July 8, 2003, the Chief Administrative Officer is negotiating a contract with the California Youth Authority to house minors that the Court deems are not appropriate for a juvenile facility. Such minors currently are detained at Men’s Central Jail. The Chief Administrative Officer expects a contract with California Youth Authority for housing, education, recreation and social and mental health services to be executed by mid-September.

“In light of the concerns raised by the Board of Corrections, as well as community advocates, it is important to take interim corrective actions to improve the conditions of minors detained in Men’s Central Jail until they are moved to the California Youth Authority. The Sheriff has indicated that he can double the time that minors spend out of their cells at Men’s Central Jail and allow the minors more time for recreation, if he is provided with overtime funding for two additional Deputy Sheriffs.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Yaroslavsky, seconded by Supervisor Knabe, unanimously carried, the Chief Administrative Officer was authorized to reallocate \$54,000.00 from the Appropriation for Contingencies to the Sheriff’s custody budget in order to cover the overtime costs of two additional Deputy Sheriffs to allow minors detained in Men's Central Jail to have more time out of their cells.
