

MOTION BY SUPERVISOR DON KNABE

Conceived as an experimental graffiti abatement project, the Department of Beaches and Harbors partnered with the Arts Commission to develop a mural for concession/restroom building walls at Dockweiler State Beach through a community participation process. The mobile art studio, **MobileMuralLab**, was commissioned to develop the art and commenced the public participation process this past Memorial Day weekend at the first "Nite-Write," a luminescent, interactive multimedia art experience on-site at the Beach, which was replicated on another night in June. The public's creative input was utilized in developing the final mural design, which is now ready to be unveiled and dedicated at Dockweiler Beach on October 10, 2012.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors waive the parking fees in an estimated amount of \$300 for an estimated 50 participants attending the Dockweiler Mural Art Dedication Ceremony to be held Wednesday, October 10, 2012, at Dockweiler State Beach.
