

**NOTICE OF \$100,000 REWARD  
OFFERED BY THE  
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles has established a \$100,000 reward offered in exchange for information leading to the apprehension (capture) and/or conviction of Christopher Jordan Dorner, a former Los Angeles Police Department officer who is suspected of injuring an LAPD officer, and the heinous murders of a Riverside police officer, and the daughter of a retired LAPD Captain and her fiancé. Dorner caused a significant threat to public safety.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the apprehension (capture) and/or conviction of Christopher Jordan Dorner must be given no later than May 13, 2013. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than July 12, 2013.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$100,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.

Any claims for the reward funds should be filed no later than July 12, 2013, with the Executive Office of the Board of Supervisors, 500 West Temple Street, Room 383 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California 90012, Attention: Christopher Jordan Dorner Reward Fund.
