Our mission is to improve the lives of women and girls through service, education,, awareness and advocacy.

Diversity is promoted and enhanced by a variety of programs to address our community needs. as follows:

1] Girls Robotics Program for STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) education - girls (ages 9-14). 2] LifeForward Workshops are designed to empower women and support economic independence and self-sufficiency in collaboration with Single Mother's Outreach, Domestic Violence Center, DCFS Single Moms & Habitat for Humanity returning women veterans.. 3] Domestic Violence Court Advocacy (DVCAP) partnering with Domestic Violence Center and two local women's organizations - mentor and advocate for victims of their human rights. 4] Young Women in Public Affairs and Jane M. Klausman Women in Business Scholarships are awarded to young women to to foster their leadership in government and public policy and advance from the classroom to the board room. 5] Virginia Wrage Grants are awarded to women in mid-life who need assistance because of a life crises. 6} Community Grants are awarded to local non-profit organizations to fund or partially fund projects that are aligned with Zonta's missin to advance the lives of women and girls. 7} Huggy Heartz Pillow Projects - Soft, comfortable pillows with shoulder straps and a pocket to hold hot/cold packs are sewn and stuffed for breast cancer patients to help ease post-surgery discomfort.

History of Organization and Time of Existence:

The Zonta Club of Santa Clarita Valley is a member of Zonta International, a worldwide service organization of professional women founded in 1919.

The Zonta Club of Santa Clarita Valley was established in 1974 and the Club's Foundation was established in 1998. The Foundation is the fundraising arm of the organization.

ATTACHMENT A

DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT EVENTS & REQUEST FOR DONATION

Each of the three Zonta Club of Santa Clarita Valley's program requests are considered events. The description of activities supporting the Request for Donation amount is detailed below.

1. Girls Robotics: The older girls (grades 7 and 8) will compete in the FIRST Lego League regional competition. They must use A) a 2013-14 challenge mat and build and program a Lego robot to complete challenges in the "Nature's Fury" competition. B) Develop a unique response to a natural disaster and present both a written and oral report on their concept. C) The team must explain to industry professionals how they designed and programmed their robot to complete the assigned tasks.

Costs: One-time annual cost - \$300 to register a team and \$75 to purchase the current year's challenge mat. Estimated cost to participate in a regional competition is \$150. Regional competitions are scheduled in November and December, 2013; the cost to participate is \$450.

2. LifeForward Workshops meet a critical need in the Santa Clarita Valley by offering workshops that are designed to empower women. Experienced instructors present topics that support economic independence and self-sufficiency. Zonta offers these workshops in collaboration with Single Mother's Outreach, Domestic Violence Center, DCFS serving Single Moms and Habitat for Humanity returning women veterans.

Seventy-nine attendees were served by nine workshops through May 18, 2013 which are held the third or fourth Saturday of each month from 10:00 am to 12:30 pm (dark in December); Speakers range from one to three for each workshop depending on the topic(s); it is anticipated three speakers will require a fee this coming year - @ \$200.00 ea. = \$600 total.

 Domestic Violence Court Advocacy program, in partnership with the local Domestic Violence Center and two other local women's organizations, mentors and advocates for victims of their human rights. Trained advocates meet weekly to assist those in need of support.

Training cost is \$150 for each trained Advocate It is anticipated there will be two to three new Advocates requiring training for a total of \$450.
