DAMAGED/STOLEN PROPERTY

Currently, there exists no insurance policy within the Department of Children and Family Services, to pay a foster parent when they allege that a foster youth has stolen or damaged property in their homes. The Department should explore options to assist foster parents in recouping losses from such incidents. An impact study would assist the County to evaluate the feasibility of paying such claims.

I, THEREFORE MOVE, THAT the Board direct the Director of Children and Family Services, in collaboration with County Counsel and the Chief Administrator Officer, to report back in 30 days with a plan to compensate foster parents when their property is damaged or stolen by foster youth.
