At its meeting held September 23, 2003, the Board took the following action:

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Supervisor Knabe made the following statement:

“The Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District surfing team, a nonprofit high school sports team, has again requested access for free parking at the Torrance Beach parking lot from October 1, 2003 to May 1, 2004 from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. before the parking lot opens for team practice. The team members want to avoid parking in the local surrounding neighborhoods, which upsets local residents and have come to the County for assistance in use of our beach parking facilities during winter months.

“The on-site parking vendor charges admission after 8:00 a.m. for a lot which is virtually vacant. The team members have to be back at school for classes and paying a flat \$4.00 fee is not practical, especially with ample public parking across the street.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Knabe, seconded by Supervisor Yaroslavsky, unanimously carried, the Board authorized the Director of Beaches and Harbors to permit the members of the Palos Verdes Peninsula Unified School District surfing team to use the Torrance County Beach parking lot for team practices, October 1, 2003 through May 1, 2004 from 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. before the parking lot opens to the public.

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
