Reestablish Reward Motion

On January 13, 2004, 24-year-old Anthony Lofton was shot and killed while at Jim's Burgers located on Lincoln Avenue near Woodbury Drive in Altadena. Two witnesses reported seeing a male black in a hooded sweatshirt running from the burger stand immediately after the gunshot was heard but no suspects are in custody to date. This board offered a reward on December 2, 2008 which has expired.

The Sheriff's Homicide Bureau is seeking reestablishment of this reward to assist with solving this crime.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors reestablish the \$10,000 reward offer in exchange for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person(s) responsible for the murder of 24-year-old Anthony Lofton on January 13, 2004 at Jim's Burgers located on Lincoln Avenue near Woodbury Drive in Altadena.
