Southern California Edison (SCE) provides electricity to more than 5,000 large and 280,000 small businesses. As part of their maintenance program, SCE regularly performs "Planned Outages" that cut off power while SCE employees work on the system. These "Planned Outages" do not provide businesses with adequate time to prepare and are performed on weekdays during business hours with no regard to the financial impact.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors send a five signature letter to the Public Utilities Commission requesting that they develop utility regulations that require a good faith effort by utilities to limit the impacts they have on businesses during construction and maintenance.
