On Monday, March 24, 2014, Felix Avelar-Duran, 53, was working as a clerk at a local business in the 1100 block of Seventh Street in the City of Long Beach when an armed gunman entered the business and during the course of a robbery, shot the victim. The victim remains in critical condition. No one has been arrested in this case.

Detectives have been unable to identify a suspect and few witnesses have come forward so far. Detectives feel it would be beneficial to offer a reward, which may prompt reluctant witnesses to come forward and provide information to identify the individual(s) responsible for this crime. They can remain anonymous.

**I, THEREFORE, MOVE** that the Board of Supervisors offer a \$10,000 reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the perpetrator(s) of this heinous crime.
