**APPROVAL OF ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 6-SALARIES, APPLICABLE ONLY
TO LACERA NON-REPRESENTED EMPLOYEES
(ALL DISTRICTS - 3 VOTES)**

SUBJECT

This letter and accompanying ordinance will make a minor correction to the non-represented salary adjustments and ordinance previously approved by the Board of Supervisors on March 25, 2014, applicable only to LACERA.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT YOUR BOARD:

Adopt the enclosed corrected ordinance amending Title 6-Salaries of the Los Angeles County Code, applicable only to LACERA, to facilitate personnel administration within LACERA.

PURPOSE/JUSTIFICATION OF RECOMMENDED ACTION

On March 25, 2104, the Board approved salary adjustments for all LACERA non-represented employees as follows: 3.0% salary adjustments effective January 16, 2014, January 1, 2015 and January 1, 2016 (the effective dates applicable to salary increases for represented employees of LACERA). The LACERA Board of Investments and the Board of Retirement had approved the salary adjustments on January 8 and 15, 2014. Subsequent to the adoption of that ordinance an omission related to the salary listing was discovered. Accordingly the recommendations provided herein will address the error.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING

Adoption of the proposed ordinance will have no fiscal impact on the County of Los Angeles. The entire cost of administering the Retirement Association, including expenses associated with salaries and benefits are a charge on the earnings of the retirement fund pursuant to Government Code Section 31580.2. There is no financing involved with this action.

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FACTS AND PROVISIONS/LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Government Code Section 31522.1 authorizes the LACERA Boards to appoint personnel, and further provides such personnel "shall be county employees and shall be subject to the county civil service or merit system rules and shall be included in the salary ordinance or resolution adopted by the boards of supervisors for the compensation of county officers and employees."

IMPACT ON CURRENT SERVICES (OR PROJECTS)

None.

The proposed ordinance has been approved as to form by the County Counsel.
