At its meeting held October 21, 2003, the Board took the following action:

Supervisor Knabe made the following statement:

“Family members, friends and fellow Marines gathered Monday to mourn the tragic death of a decorated Marine who survived a land mine explosion during Operation Iraqi Freedom only to be killed at home in Long Beach while on a weekend leave from Camp Pendleton.

“Lance Corporal Sok Khak Ung, a 22-year-old combat engineer who was awarded a Purple Heart for his participation in the rescue operation of Army Pfc. Jessica Lynch in April, died early Sunday morning after a gunman opened fire on him and several friends at his father's home.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Knabe, seconded by Supervisor Yaroslavsky, unanimously carried, the Board established a \$10,000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Lance Corporal Sok Khak Ung, a 22-year-old combat engineer in the United States Marine Corp., who was shot and killed at his father's home located in the 1200 block of East 7th Street on Sunday, October 19, 2003 at approximately 1:07 a.m., in the City of Long Beach.

**NOTICE OF \$10,000 REWARD
OFFERED BY THE
LOS ANGELES COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS**

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles is offering a \$10,000 reward for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for the murder of Lance corporal Sok Khak Ung, a 22-year-old combat engineer in the United States Marine Corp., who was shot and killed at his father's home located in the 1200 block of East 7th Street on Sunday, October 19, 2003 at approximately 1:07 a.m., in the City of Long Beach.

Any person having any information related to this crime is requested to call Detectives Bryan McMahon or David Rios at the Long Beach Police Department, Homicide Division at (562) 570-7244 and refer to Report No. 03-85986.

The terms of the reward provide that:

- The information given that leads to the determination of the identity, the apprehension and conviction of any person or persons must be given no later than January 19, 2004. All reward claims must be in writing and shall be received no later than March 19, 2004.
- The total County payment of any and all rewards shall in no event exceed \$10,000 and no claim shall be paid prior to conviction unless the Board of Supervisors makes a finding of impossibility of conviction due to the death or incapacity of the person or persons responsible for the crime or crimes.
- The County reward may be apportioned between various persons and/or paid for the conviction of various persons as the circumstances fairly dictate.

Any claims for the reward funds should be filed no later than March 19, 2004 with the Executive Officer of the Board of Supervisors, 500 West Temple Street, Room 383 Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration, Los Angeles, California 90012, Attention: Lance Cpl.
