REWARD EXTENSION MOTION – WORLD WAR II MEMORIAL

During Easter weekend, portions of the World War II Memorial located at the Lancaster Cemetery District in Lancaster were vandalized. Outdoor lighting and fixtures were stolen. An American flag and the flag hoisted to honor POW-MIA troops missing in action or taken prisoner of war were also stolen from the Veterans Court of Honor. The Lancaster Sheriff’s Station is seeking the public’s assistance with information that can help them solve this case.

The \$20,000 reward offer approved by this Board on May 6, 2014 is due to expire on August 4, 2014.

The Sheriff’s Department is still seeking assistance from the public with information that may aid in their investigation and requests the extension of this reward.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors extend the \$20,000 reward in exchange for information leading to the arrest and/or conviction of the suspect(s) responsible for vandalizing portions of the World War II Memorial and stealing an American flag and the flag hoisted to honor POW-MIA troops.
