Supervisor Burke made the following statement:

“For the first time in its over 50-year history NASCAR has announced an unprecedented championship racing event that will bring together six of its major regional racing divisions in the same place at the same time for a ‘Showdown’ to determine a true national champion. Irwindale Speedway has been chosen for this very prestigious event. This event will bring together 70 top NASCAR Elite and Grand National Division drivers from around the country, and it will not only have wide national recognition, but formidable support from the over 60 tracks located in 27 states that will be represented by their fastest and finest.”

Therefore, on motion of Supervisor Burke, seconded by Supervisor Antonovich, unanimously carried, the Board proclaimed November 3 through November 9, 2003 as "NASCAR Week" throughout Los Angeles County, in recognition of Irwindale Speedway's 5th Anniversary and its prestigious unprecedented championship racing event entitled, "The NASCAR Toyota All-Star Showdown," to be held the weekend of November 6 through November 8, 2003 at Irwindale Speedway.
