

The Brown Act entitles a member of the public to speak before a governing body and express their concerns and ideas regarding any issue before the Board. The Brown Act also allows any member of the public to address the Board on any other issue, but the Board is prohibited from acting on it unless the matter is already on the agenda.

During the last several Board meetings, there has been a member of the public who has made a consistent mockery of the Brown Act by holding several items at once. He has consistently disrupted our Board meetings, directly attacked members of this Board and has not followed the rules and guidelines of this Board of Supervisors and the Brown Act.

I THEREFORE MOVE, that Board enact an immediate policy limiting this abuse of the Brown Act by prohibiting disruptive members of the public to hold more than one item after the majority of the Board has determined that his/her actions are inappropriate and indeed disruptive.
