3.8 - COMPREHENSIVE DATA TRACKING

- **Creates a New Performance Monitoring and Recording System (PMRS)**
 - Will replace existing data systems (PPI and FAST)
- **Progressing as scheduled**
 - On track to be complete December 2016
- **Preliminary Data Entry portion is complete**
- **Recording, Monitoring, and Summary Report functions in development**



3.12- BODY SCANNERS

- **Three Body Scanners Installed**
 - Two at IRC
 - One at CRDF
- **IRC**
 - 3,064 inmates scanned from 08/07/14 -10/17/14
 - Resulting in recovery of one live bullet round
- **CRDF Pilot program began on 11/10/14**
 - 585 inmates scanned from 11/10/14 - 12/09/14
 - Resulting in one recovery of narcotics (Heroin)
 - Inmates are complying with scanner protocols



CHALLENGES WITH BODY SCANNERS

- **Staff Intensive**
 - Evaluation of Staffing and Training Needs on-going
- **Equipment Size and Space Requirements**
- **Scanner malfunction at IRC (now repaired)**
- **Vender Issues**
 - Delivery of CRDF system schedule slipped
 - Inability to send correct replacement parts



4.11- MANAGEMENT STAFF ALLOCATIONS

- **Board approved \$ 1.6 million for administrative support staff**
- **19 Positions Authorized**
 - 2 staff positions have been filled
 - 17 staff positions are in the interview stage
- **Anticipated all items will be filled April 2015**



4.12- IMPAAC

- **Phase II hiring continues**
 - IMPAAC staff totals 38 filled positions
 - Head Compliance Officer position anticipated to be filled January 2015
 - Hiring process continues for 13 vacant Items
- **Phase III hiring**
 - Will begin July 2015
 - 13 additional items will be added



CUSTODY SPECIFIC TRAINING GOALS

Training Class	June 2015 Goal	Dec 2014 Actual
Identifying and Interacting with Mentally Ill Inmates	70%	61%
Force Concepts / Ethics	60%	49%
Jail Specific Restraining Techniques	65%	55%
Use of Force Investigations for Supervisors	97%	97%
Inmate Extraction Training	90%	80%



7.1- INVESTIGATIVE AND DISCIPLINARY SYSTEM

- **Internal Affairs Bureau (IAB) Hiring**
 - 18 of 19 funded items filled
 - Phase III will add 9 items
 - IAB Caseload 10 Cases Per Investigator
 - Average completion time 9 months per case
- **Internal Criminal Investigations Bureau (ICIB) Hiring**
 - All funded items filled
 - Phase III will add 13 items
 - ICIB Caseload 6.5 Cases Per Investigator
 - Average completion time 4.9 months



7.14 - INMATE GRIEVANCES

Grievance Process will be Revamped as part of Rosas Settlement

- New Grievance Forms
- New Policies
- Grievance Coordinators
- Monthly Reports and Analysis
- Timeliness of Response



7.15– CCTV SYSTEM

- **CRDF installation to begin in early 2015**
 - Completion targeted by the end of 2015
- **PDC network upgrades will begin in 2015**
 - Upgrades and installation will be done in 3 phases, targeted for completion in 2018
