On November 3, 2014, the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) issued a request for project applications for the California Federal Lands Access Program (FLAP). The goal of FLAP is to improve access to Federal lands and the opportunities afforded by those lands. This motion requests authorization to apply for grant funding for the Santa Anita Canyon Road Rehabilitation Project.

Santa Anita Canyon Road is a scenic mountain road providing access to recreational opportunities, including hiking, picnic areas, and campgrounds in the Angeles National Forest. Santa Anita Canyon Road provides access to the historic Adams' Pack Station, a launch point for transporting supplies to permanent cabins in the forest area inaccessible by motor vehicle. The Project would enhance accessibility by rehabilitating Santa Anita Canyon Road, including storm damage protective retaining wall repair and culvert construction/reconstruction among other types of work.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve and authorize the Director of Public Works or her designee to submit an application for the Santa Anita Canyon Road Rehabilitation Project for the California FLAP Grant Funds and to enter into a reimbursable agreement not to exceed \$10,000 for further project scoping by FHWA should the project be selected for the short list for consideration of grant funding.

2. Direct the Director of Public Works, or her designee, upon notification of FHWA approval of the project application and grant award to return to the Board of Supervisors with a:
 - a) preliminary project financing plan to request authorization to accept the California FLAP grant funds on behalf of the County;
 - b) request for authorization to enter into Project and/or reimbursable agreements with FHWA and the Angeles National Forest to identify respective agency roles, responsibilities, and funding required to complete the design, environmental impact analysis, and construction; and
 - c) preliminary maintenance funding plan to maintain the Project for a period of 20 years or life of the Project, whichever is greater.
