Proclaim February 2015 as Black History Month in Los Angeles County

The County of Los Angeles and its African-American Employees Association will sponsor the official annual observance of Black History Month on Thursday, February 26, 2015, at 11:30 a.m., in Room 381-B of the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration.

With the theme "*A Century of Black Life, History & Culture*" Program highlights will feature the Living Legends Honorees, performances by SHINE Mawusi (Sisters Healing Inspiring Nurturing and Empowering), poetry readings, musical entertainment and a thrilling Fashion Show featuring County employees in traditional African attire.

The annual observance of Black History Month demonstrates the County's respect for diversity and its willingness to undertake programs that have public value.

WE, THEREFORE, MOVE THAT THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:

1. Proclaim February 2015 as "Black History Month" in the County of Los Angeles in support of the annual celebration on Thursday, February 26, 2015;
2. Waive fees, totaling \$1,000.00, excluding liability insurance, for 50 cars to park at the Music Center for persons attending the Black History Month program; and
3. Encourage County departments, including the Board of Supervisors' Executive Office, Chief Executive Office, Internal Services, and Assessor's Office to provide the necessary support for the annual celebration.
