On December 10, 2004, Joseph Molina was shot and killed by two robbers while working in a Subway Restaurant in the City of Whittier. Molina was complying with the robbers' demands for cash, but they shot Molina anyway.

On December 14, 2004, this Board approved a \$5,000 reward in exchange for information that would lead to the conviction of the suspect(s) responsible for this crime. Subsequently, an informant provided the necessary information and testimony which led to the conviction of the person responsible for this crime.

I, THEREFORE, MOVE that the Board of Supervisors reinstate the \$5,000 reward in order for the informant who provided the information that led to the suspect(s) conviction to be eligible to file a claim for the reward and that the same terms and provisions of the original reward be offered.
