At its meeting held January 6, 2004, the Board took the following action:

The following statement was entered into the record for Supervisor Burke:

“For the last three years, University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA) has hosted a Mock Trial Tournament featuring teams from universities across the nation. UCLA has four mock trial teams that compete against other universities and colleges at competitions sponsored by the American Mock Trial Association (AMTA). The University of Southern California’s team also participates in this event. The AMTA national competitions are very similar to the junior high school and high school mock trial competitions sponsored by the Constitutional Rights Foundation. UCLA has received approval from the Presiding Judge of the Central Courthouse and the Court Facilities Department to hold its 4th annual Mock Trial Tournament at the Stanley Mosk Courthouse (Central District of the Superior Court) in downtown Los Angeles on Saturday, January 10, 2004 from 8:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.”

Merritt Holloway addressed the Board.

After discussion, at the suggestion of Supervisor Burke and on motion of Supervisor Knabe, seconded by Supervisor Burke, unanimously carried (Supervisor Yaroslavsky being absent), the Board waived fees in the amount of \$2,250.00, excluding the cost of liability insurance, for the use of 18 courtrooms and County parking facilities at the Stanley Mosk Courthouse for the UCLA Mock Trial Invitational Tournament, to be held January 10, 2004.
