This is a recommendation to settle for \$700,000, the lawsuit filed by Aline Bilamdjian, Guardian Ad Litem of decedent Javier Mendez's two minor children, N.A.M. and N.O.M., and Misty Castro, Guardian Ad Litem of Mr. Mendez's other minor child, A.C., against the County of Los Angeles, and five Sheriff's Deputies alleging federal civil rights violations based on excessive force, and State-law

wrongful death and related claims stemming from the shooting of Mr. Mendez.

Due to the risks and uncertainties of litigation, a reasonable settlement at this time will avoid further litigation costs. Therefore, a full and final settlement of the case in the amount of \$700,000 is recommended.
