FAMILY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (FAP)

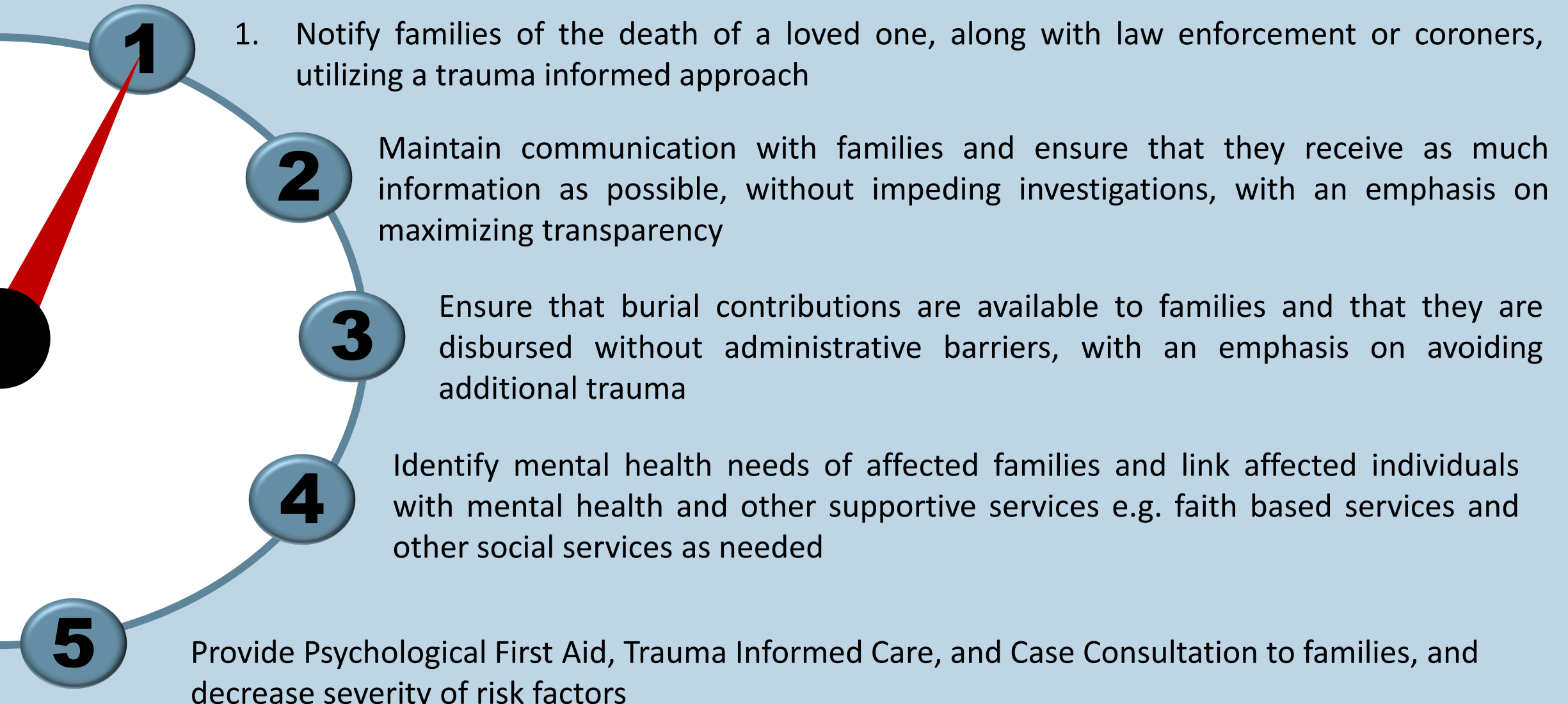


WHAT IS FAMILY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM?

The FAP consists of trained Family Assistance Advocates (FAA) who receive and respond to incidents of (LASD) officer involved shootings, in custody death (community/hospital, jail settings). FAAs support families, friends and witnesses impacted by such incidents and provide mental health services, social services and burial expenses.

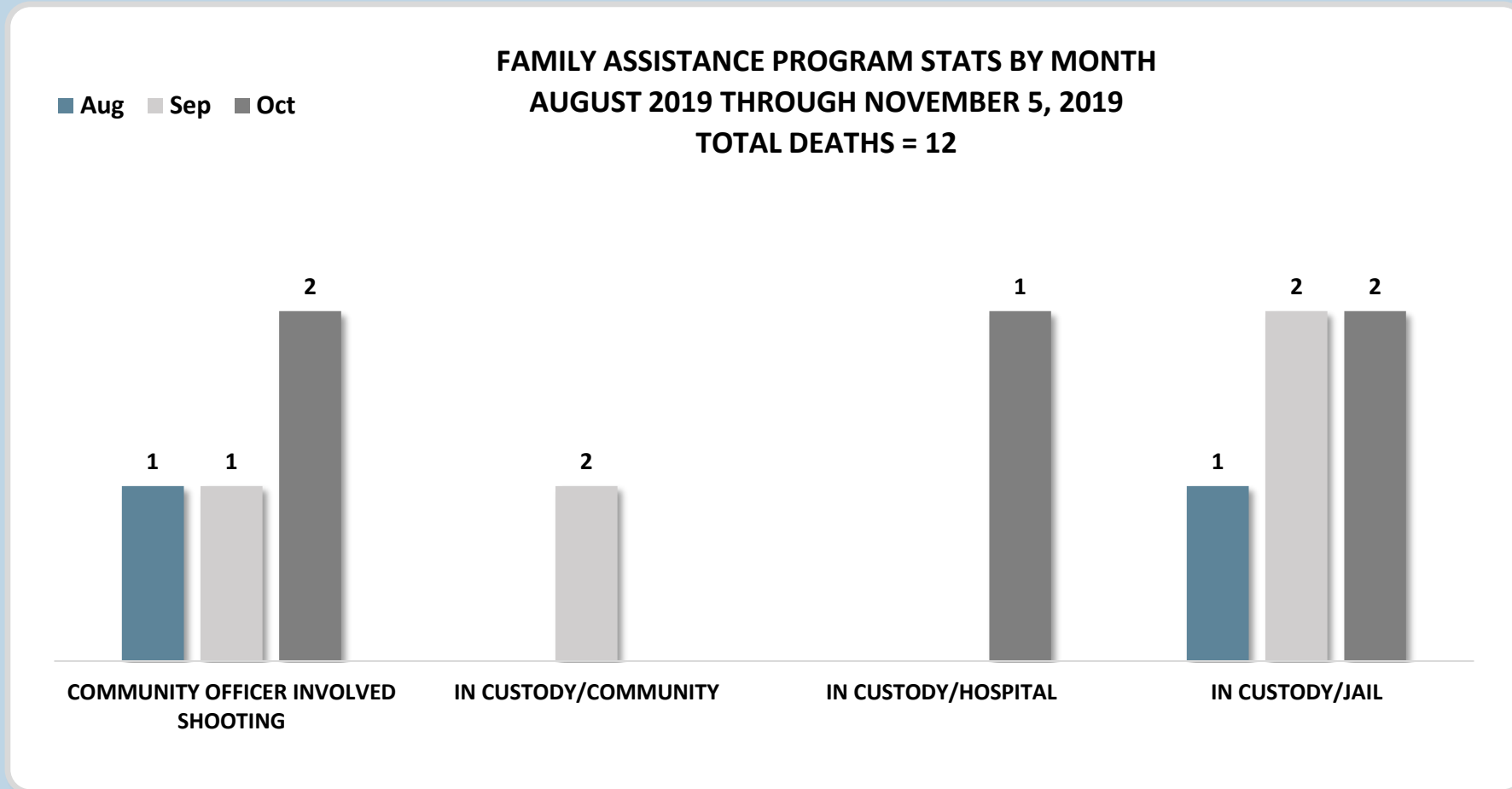


WHAT DO FAMILY ASSISTANCE ADVOCATES DO?
