



RESOLUTION OF THE SHERIFF CIVILIAN OVERSIGHT COMMISSION

RESOLUTION CONDEMNING ACTS OF VIOLENCE

The Sheriff Civilian Oversight Commission of the County of Los Angeles (Commission), California hereby resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, on September 12, 2020, an unidentified gunman attempted to murder two Los Angeles County Sheriff Deputies while on duty in the city of Compton;

WHEREAS, the Commission serves as an advisory board to the Los Angeles Sheriff's Department, the Board of Supervisors and the public, and each of its Commissioners is a member of the Los Angeles County community;

WHEREAS, the residents of Compton as well as all other communities within the County of Los Angeles deserve to live in a community free of violent incidents that further ignite community trauma;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Civilian Oversight Commission does hereby strongly and unequivocally condemn the premeditated attack on Sheriff Deputies that occurred on September 12, 2020 and any act of violence against community members and law enforcement.
