Figure 1. Total Funding Amounts by CFCI Strategy

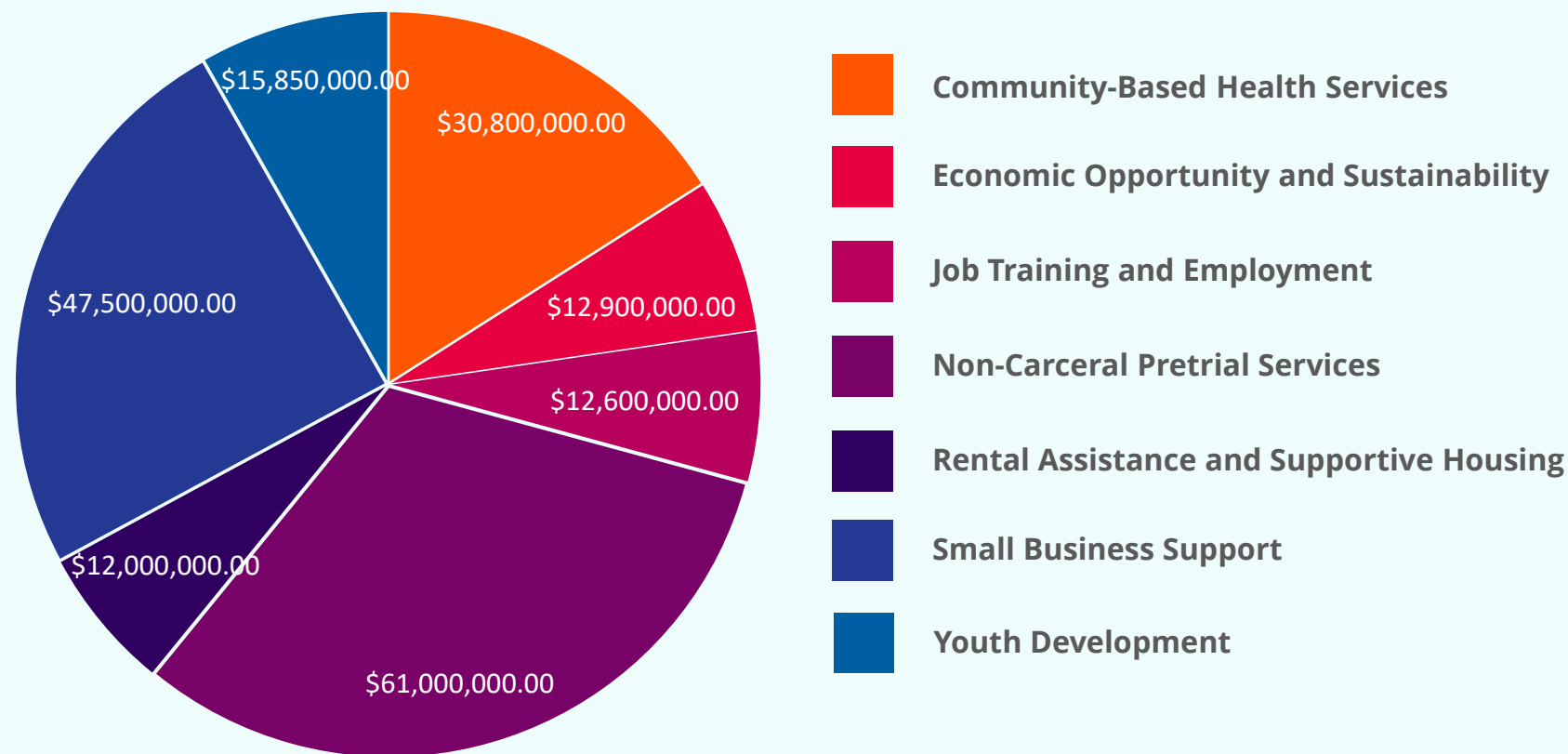


Figure 2. CFCI-Only Funded Projects by Implementation Stage (total = 17)

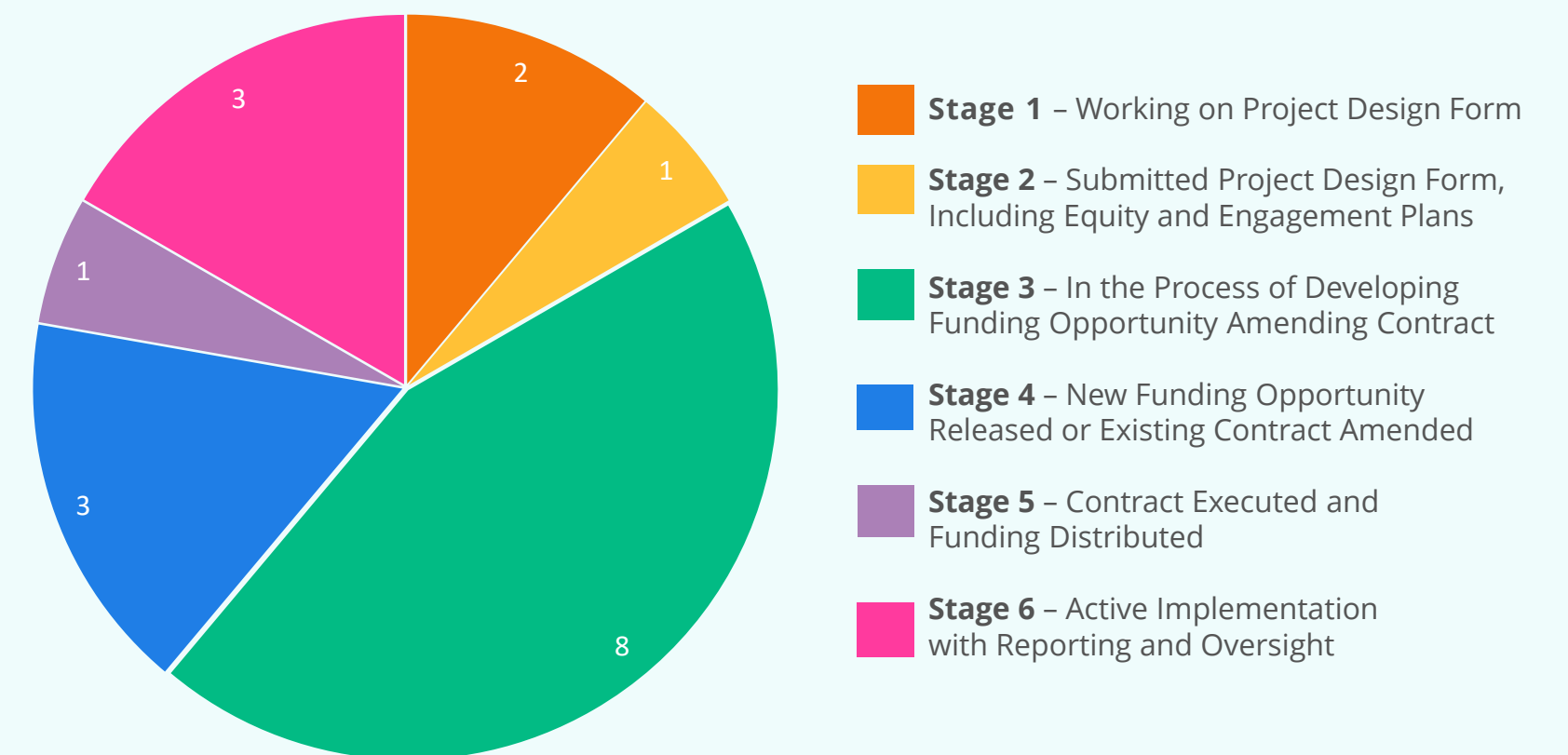


Figure 3. Populations for projects that have submitted project design information

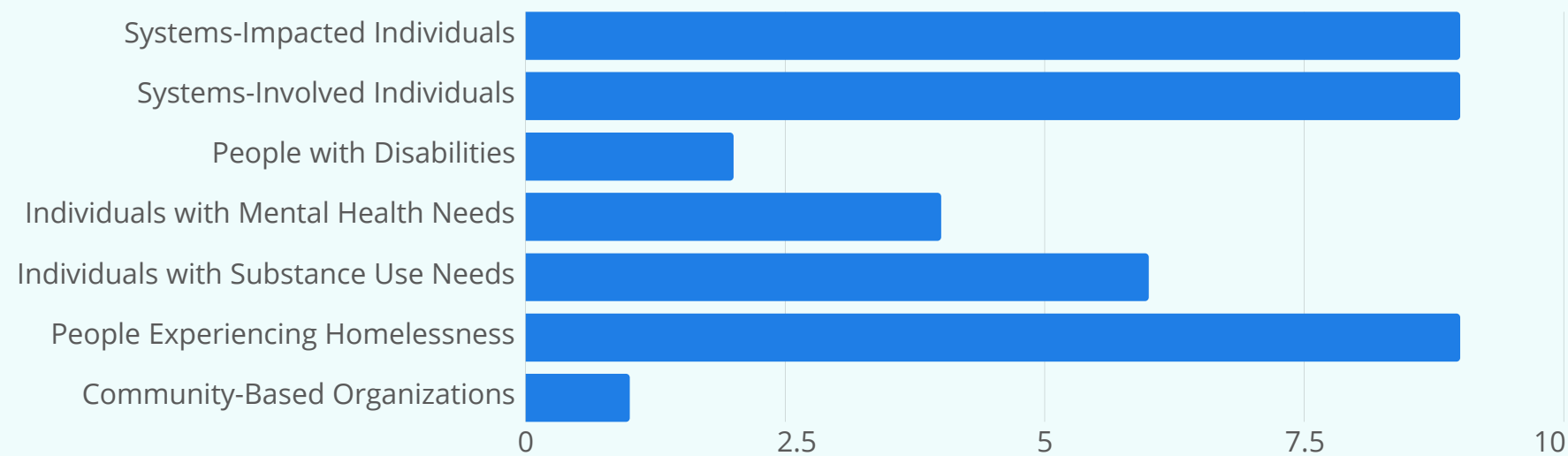
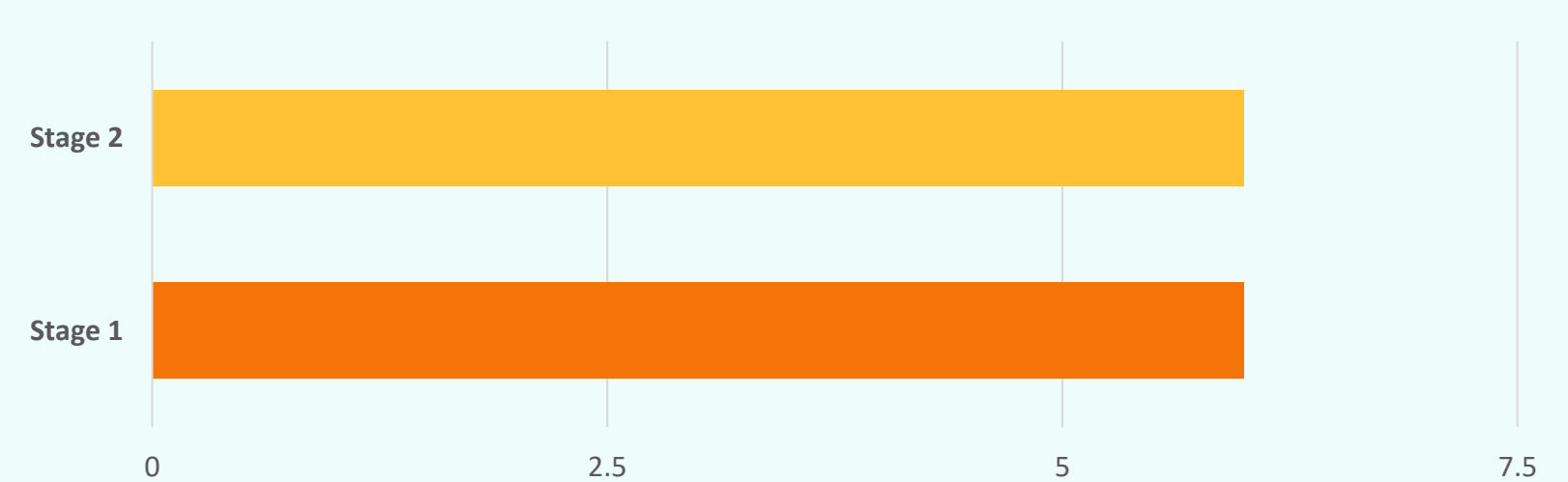


Figure 4. ARP-Funded Projects by Implementation Stage (total = 12)
