This dangerous condition lawsuit against the Department of Public Works arises from alleged injuries received when Plaintiff tripped and fell on a sidewalk.

**b. Claim of Nischell M. Tolbert**

This claim seeks compensation from the Sheriff's Department for property damage allegedly caused by chemical agents deployed in order to apprehend a suspect barricaded in Claimant's house.

The Claims Board approved the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$45,983.20.

**c. Alice Gomez Daly v. James Chambliss  
Riverside Superior Court Case No. RIC 1715753**

This lawsuit against the Sheriff's Department alleges Plaintiff was assaulted and falsely imprisoned during a traffic incident.

The Claims Board approved the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$30,000.

**d. Eduardo Solorzano v. County of Los Angeles

The Claims Board approved the settlement of this matter in the amount of \$30,000.


